Show Rules and Regulations

- (1) The Event Organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- (2) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- (3) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- (4) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:

(a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases or has suffered a contagious disease in the previous 21 days.

- (b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
- (c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- (5) It is the Teams Captain's responsibility to ensure the team is available for their division and running order.
- (6) The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- (7) All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- (8) All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- (9) BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.

(10) In the event of a 3 way tie winner will be decided on times. In a 2 way tie the winner is who beat who.

(11)This is an OUTDOOR tournament, In the event of the tournament being cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received

(12) All dogs must be on the lead outside of the competition field when on RSPCA land during open hours.

Directions to RSPCA Block Fen

Postcode is PE15 0FB however many SAT NAVS will take you the wrong way and you could end up in a farm! Even Google maps doesn't show Nix Hill Road unless you look at Google images. For Sat Navs use PE15 0PL, this will get you to the entrance of Nix Hill Road where you just need to follow the signs to the RSPCA

From A1 / A14 Interchange

Take the A141 to Chatteris and stay on the A141 to March. Approx 3.5 miles after the Chatteris (A141 / A142) roundabout turn right towards Manea. Look for the RSPCA sign. Then turn first right again into Nix Hill Road, again it will be signposted to the RSPCA. Follow this road (single track with passing places) for about 1 1/2 miles, go past the entrance to the parachute centre and past the entrance to the RSPCA. The field is then on your right hand side.

From M11 South

Either stay on M11 until you get to A14 West and go to Huntingdon. Then follow directions above.

Or

Take J14 onto A14 east. Then take A10 to Ely. Stay on A10 at Ely (left turn) and then turn left onto A142. Stay on A142 until you reach the A142 / A141 roundabout at Chatteris. Approx 3.5 miles after the Chatteris (A141 / A142) roundabout turn right towards Manea. Look for the RSPCA sign. Then turn first right again into Nix Hill Road, again it will be signposted to the RSPCA. Follow this road (single track with passing places) for about 1 1/2 miles, go past the entrance to the parachute centre and past the entrance to the RSPCA. The field is then on your right hand side.

From A17 North and A1 North

Get onto the A47 either south past Wisbech or East from Peterborough. At The Guyhirn Roundabout turn South on the A141 to March. Stay on this road until you get to March and turn right onto the A141 (March Bypass). Follow this and go straight over the next roundabout to Chatteris. Take the left turn to Manea, look for the RSPCA or Parachute Centre sign. Then turn right into Nix Hill Road, again signposted RSPCA and Parachute Centre. Follow this road (single track with passing places) for about 1 1/2 miles, go past the entrance to the parachute centre and past the entrance to the RSPCA. The field is then on your right hand side.
