Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. The Event Organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.

- 2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- 3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the tournament. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 4. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - (a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
 - (b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - (c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 5. It is the Team Captain's responsibility to ensure each team is available for their division and running order.

6. The Event Organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of any unforeseen circumstances.

7. All people and dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, people or property whilst at the event.

8. All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.

9. No alcohol to be consumed within or around the ring. No smoking within or around the ring.

10. If circumstances make it necessary for the tournament to be cancelled, the Event Organiser(s) reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting them from the entry fees received.

- 11. No person shall impugn the decision of the Head Judge or Judges.
- 12. Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.

DIRECTIONS TO EGLINTON COUNTRY PARK KA12 8TA IRVINE, NORTH AYRSHIRE

From North

M8 into Glasgow, join M77 (Kilmarnock, Prestwick Airport) to Kilmarnock, branch left signposted HURLFORD/GALSTON/CROSSHOUSE at roundabout take 4th exit onto A71 ** at roundabout take 2nd exit onto A71, at Corsehill Mount Roundabout take 2nd exit onto A71, at Warrix Interchange Roundabout take the 3rd exit then merge onto the A78, at Eglinton Interchange branch left then merge onto A737, at Eglinton Interchange Roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A737, turn left.

From South

M74 to junc 8, onto A71 to Kilmarnock, take 3rd exit onto A71 **as above

From East

A70 to Cumnock, then A76 to Kilmarnock then take 2nd exit to A71 **as above
