### LIVE WIRES FLYBALL TEAMS

Sutton Fields, Sutton Weaver, Nr Runcorn, Cheshire – 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> May 2009

#### Information

- (1) This is a limited flyball competition (sanctioned by the BFA) with a maximum entry of 60 open teams. There will also be a starter's competition (separate ring) for a maximum of 12 teams per day and pairs/singles may also be arranged in the same ring if time allows. It is anticipated that up to 5 open and 2 starter divisions will compete each day. No refunds will be given unless the space can be filled.
- (2) Applications for the \*\*Starters event must be made at the same time as for the Open competition. All entries will be taken strictly in the order received. Each team will be treated as an individual entry [BFA rules 4.1 (g)].
- (3) No open entries will be accepted after the closing date.
- (4) Camping is available at the price shown on the entry form. On site there is a clubhouse with toilets, bar, café & picnic area. The toilets will closed overnight and open again early in the morning. Those wishing to stay overnight please confirm these times nearer the date of the competition.
  - \*\* Payment for starter teams may be deferred until the day.
- (5) <u>DIRECTIONS</u> From East & M6(Inc 20) onto M56 towards Chester. At Inc.11 turn left onto the A56 following signs to Sutton Weaver. A533 from Northwich comes in from left then go over M56 and turn left (A56) After going under a railway bridge it is immediately on the left. From Chester/N. Wales come off on Inc. 12. Follow signs to Frodsham, Turn left onto A56 Sutton Weaver. Sutton Fields is on the right just before a railway bridge. Look for Signs to Sutton Fields Golf Driving Range. #### **Show Rules and Regulations**

- (1) The Event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- (2) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- (3) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- (4) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
  - (a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
  - (b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
  - (c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- (5) It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for their class and running order.
- (6) No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- (7) The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- (8) All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- (9) No alcohol can be consumed within or around the ring.
- (10) All owners/handlers must clean up after their dog. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- (11) If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
- (12) For safety reasons the farmyard & stables are OUT OF BOUNDS.
- (13) On and around the flyball field a strict speed limit (10 mph) will apply and vehicle movement restrictions will apply throughout the event.
- (14) Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.
