Show Rules and Regulations

- 1) The event organisers reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing, within the BFA.
- 2) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- 3) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 4) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases;
 - b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal;
 - c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 5) It is the Team Captain's responsibility to ensure the Team is available for their class and running order.
- 6) No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 7) The organisers reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 8) All dogs are entered in this event at their owner's risk and, whilst every care will be taken, the event organisers cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss, however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 9) All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 10) If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
- 11) Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.



The tournament will take place at the Cornbury Park Game & Country Fair. There will be Clay Shooting, Gun dog events, Lurcher & Terrier Show/Racing, Ferret Show/Racing, Heavy Horse Displays, Birds of Prey (Arena & Static), Fly Casting Demonstrations, Rural Crafts, Air Rifle Coaching, Arena Attractions, Craft & Fine Food Marquees, Country Clothing & Equipment Stands, Cookery Theatre including Celebrity Chef at the fair.

Directions from North:

- Leave M40 at J15
- At the roundabout, take the fourth exit onto A429
- Stay on A429 until you pass Halford (~12m)
- At next roundabout, take the first exit onto A3400
- At the roundabout, turn right onto Banbury Road A361 (~12m)
- Bear left onto Chipping Norton Road (~3m)
- Stay on this road until you reach the Show (~4m)

Directions from South:

- Leave M40 at J8
- Continue onto A40
- Exit onto A44 (~27m)
- Turn left onto B4437 (~7m)
- Continue on B4437
- Bear left onto unnamed road (~6m)
- Stay on this road until you reach the Show (~4m)

Declared times must be submitted in writing (or email) at least 14 days before the tournament and must be at least one second slower than seed time. (BFA Rule 4.5)
