



Show rules and regulations...please read

NB: THERE WILL BE NO MOVMENT OF TRAFFIC WITHIN THE SHOWGROUND BETWEEN 8.30AM AND 6PM – this will be strictly adhered to by the show organisers.

Dogs must be kept on lead and under control at all times whilst on the showground.

No generators or ground level BBQ's are allowed, an emergency mains power supply will be available.

The event organisers reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any persons not in good standing with the BFA.

It is the team captains responsibility to ensure their team is available and on time for their divisions and running orders.

No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.

The organisers reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.

All dogs are entered at this event at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken, the event organisers cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss, however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.

All owners must clear up after their dogs, failure to do so will result in that person being asked to leave the venue. Repeated offences from the same team will result in the whole team being asked to leave the show.

Current BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the tournament.
