Directions to Ayrshire Canine Centre

From the North:

Take Junc 22 on M8 onto M77 then continue on to A77 Approx 34 miles. At BankField R/B take 1st exit for A713 for Castle Douglas. Travel for 1.6 miles then turn left into Mosshill Business Park.

From the South:

Take Junc 12 from M74 onto A70 Ayr, at R/B take 1st Exit A70 Ayr. Travel for 22 miles at RB take 2nd exit A70 Ayr Rd continue for 9.8 miles Then turn Left at B742, taking 1st left to stay on B742 for 3 miles Then turn right on A713 then 2nd left into Mosshill Business Park
