# Show rules and regulations

N.B Team Captains/ Managers are responsible for ensuring that all members of their teams and accompanying party are informed of the rules and regulations pertaining to this tournament.

1. The event organiser reserves the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of (a). any person not in good standing with the BFA. or (b). any person not complying with the request of the parking stewards, security personnel.
2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs at the event is not allowed.
4. A dog must be withdrawn from the competition if it is:-
  - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.
  - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
  - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
5. It is the team captain's responsibility to ensure that the team is available for its races
6. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
7. The organiser reserves the right to make any alterations deemed necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
8. All dogs are entered in this event at their owners risk and, whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 9 **All owners/handlers must clear up** after their dogs anywhere in the grounds. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 10 Each team captain must ensure that all rubbish is removed or put in bins before leaving the site.
11. **All dogs are to be kept on a lead when not actually racing during the opening hours of the game fair especially in the vicinity of the racing area.**
12. If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
13. Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Tournament.
14. All teams entering are expected to assist with ring party duties as requested by the tournament organiser.

**The Carlton tournament takes place in the grounds of Carlton Towers originally built in the 17<sup>th</sup> Century but much rebuilt in 1820 and again by Pugin 1874. The house is the Yorkshire home of the Duke of Norfolk. It is the home of the Hon. Fitzalan Howard and is open to the public. The village of Carlton is approx. 7 mls. from Selby which is 14 mls from the walled city of York. Travelling for most people is by way of Junction 35 or 36 from M62**

## Directions to Carlton Towers.

The route is usually well signed to Selby Game Fair Carlton Towers. Leave the M62 at Junction 36 take the A614 Selby to the first roundabout. Turn right onto A645 Drax. At Drax roundabout turn right to Camblesforth roundabout. Then take the left turn to Carlton. The entrance to the grounds is on the left but may be at either end of the village. Please follow the instructions.
