## Information

- (1) These are limited indoor flyball competitions (sanctioned by the BFA) run on thick nonribbed rubber matting, with a maximum entry of 24 open teams. No refunds will be given unless the space can be filled.
- (2) Should on any day the entry fall below the limit, a STARTERS DIVISION may be organised.
- (3) All entries will be taken strictly in the order received. Each team will be treated as an individual entry [BFA rules 4.1 (g)]
- (4) Unless there are spaces, no entries will be accepted after the closing date.

### (5) DIRECTIONS : POST CODE CH5 1SA

<u>From North or East to M56</u>. Travel East to J 15 and turn off to Ellesmere Port/A53. Keep in left lane (don't go onto M53)At bottom of slip road, turn L onto A5117. Following signs to Cheshire Oaks Outlet Centre & Ellesmere Port Get into R hand lane and turn R at traffic lights (B5132), then keep left at the roundabout at Cheshire Oaks\*\* At the next roundabout (Collisium on R), take  $2^{nd}$  Rand into Stanney Lane(still B5132). On your L pass David Lloyd Tennis Centre and Stanney HS/Leisure Centre is also on L immediately afterwards –  $1^{st}$  gate. Straight on to Car Park with Entrance to Centre on left, before playing fields

<u>From Wirral</u>\*\*Follow M53 towards Ellesmere Port and as from \*\* above

<u>From N.Wales via A55.++</u> via Queensferry towards Birkenhead and follow M56 signs Take A5117 towards M6/M53. Turn off before M56 ie. L at Longlooms Rd (B5132)to Ellesmere Port, then from \*\* above.

<u>From Midlands M6, Jnc 16</u> (A500) towards Nantwich then onto A51 via Tarporley towards Chester/N. Wales. Where you meet A55 turn towards N.Wales. Then look for Birkenhead and M56 signs, then as from++ above.

### Show Rules and Regulations

- (1) The Event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- (2) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- (3) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- (4) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is :
  - (a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
  - (b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
  - (c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- (5) It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for their class and running order.
- (6) No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- (7) The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- (8) All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- (9) No alcohol can be consumed within or around the ring.
- (10) All owners/handlers must clean up after their dog. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- (11) If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
- (12) Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.
