Please note: Final running orders will be sent by email to team captain's approx 1 week prior to the event. Please make sure you have included your email address. Any teams requiring it by post please enclose a stamped addressed envelope. Two minutes warm up will be allowed between races throughout the tournament.

Show Rules and Regulations

- 1. The tournament organisers(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any persons not in good standing with the BFA
- 2. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 3. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament
- 4. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 5. A dog must be withdrawn from the tournament if it is:
 - 1. Suffering from an infectious or contagious disease
 - 2. A danger to the safety of any person or animal
 - 3. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
- 6. It is the Team Captain's Responsibility to ensure the team is available for their division and running order
- 7. The organisers(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances
- 8. All dogs enter in the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the tournament organisers(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event
- 9. All owners/ handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 10. Current BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament
- 11. No alcohol to be consumed within or around the ring. No smoking within the ring.
- 12. If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received

Directions – WF7 5AF

- From the M62, Jct 32 the venue is approx 3 miles
- At Jct 32 take the A639 exit to Pontefract / Castleford
- At the roundabout take the exit onto the A639 / Park Road heading towards Pontefract
- After 1.5 miles at traffic lights take the A645 towards Wakefield
- Venue is on the left after approx 1.1 miles Farmer Copley's Farm Shop
- There is access to the field through the main farm Shop entrance
